**Recruiter's Award 1st Quarter 2015-2016**

In honor of Pope Francis' visit to the United States in September, 2015 a special incentive is being offered to all recruiters. Between July 1, 2015 and September 30, 2015, you will receive 2,000 VIP points for every new or former member recruited in this time period in addition to a medallion similar to the one shown for the first new or former member recruited only.

Examples:

1. You recruit 5 new members in this time frame: you get only one medallion plus 10,000 VIP points.
2. You recruit 1 new member in this time frame: you get only one medallion plus 2,000 VIP points.

**VIP Club Eligibility.** Members are eligible for the VIP Club after successfully recruiting a minimum of two members. This includes all new applications, as well as recruitment of former members.

The Supreme Council collects and maintains the information from Section 6 of the Membership Document to ensure that recruiters are promptly credited and properly honored for their efforts.
