### From the desk of the Worthy Financial Secretary, Membership Dues Billing for 2016 will be sent out soon!

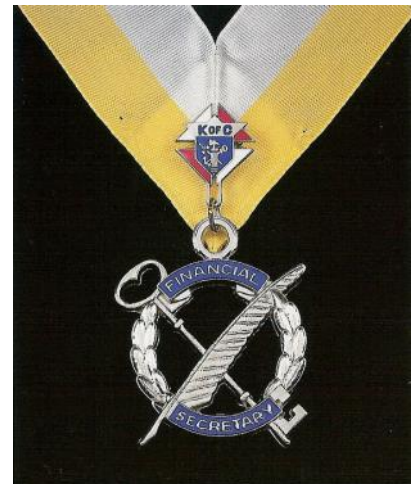
You may receive a membership bill by email, or in the USPS mail, or both.

### New Business

This would avoid \$15 delivery charge of any other method of delivery. This is a budgeted item for 2015. Rich R made a motion for this to come from the CC. Seconded, passed.

**Suspension of member** - Del is concerned about a 4<sup>th</sup> Degree member that has moved out of the area. Del thinks that he should be suspended. Discussion on if this member's dues are current. WFS will need to check on that item. If this member is going to be suspended, WFS will need to check on the procedures of KofC Supreme & WSC.

**Council Budget for 2016** – WFS brought up the council budget. During discussion, it was pointed out that the budget has to be a balanced (or zero) budget.

**CRE Tax Liability** – Dan O brought up that the tax forms have not been filed for a couple of years. To get rid of any possibility of tax liabilities coming back to haunt us, we will need to pay \$400 and file a retro catch-up. Then we can file paperwork to dissolve and there will be no possibility of past tax liabilities. After some discussion, there was a motion to pay the \$400 to close out the 501c3 retro reinstatement. Passed.

### MARCH FOR LIFE

The March For Life in Olympia will be held on Tuesday, January 19<sup>th</sup>, 2016. There will be a Mass at 8:00am at St Mary's, Anacortes and the bus will depart for Olympia at 8:30am. The bus fare is \$15 for adults and children 12 years of age and over. For children ages 5 to 11 years the fare is \$5, and children under 5 years of age will ride free.

Signups will begin after masses weekend of Jan. 2nd & 3rd and continue with the following weekend masses. All reserved signups must be paid in advance by January 10th after which all unpaid seats will be open to those on a first-come, first-serve basis (all signup fares are final).

Those who cannot attend but would like to help a person or a family who cannot afford the expense can make a donation to St. Mary's designating that it is for the March For Life.
