Fel Catabay for his dedication in serving the council, the church and the community.

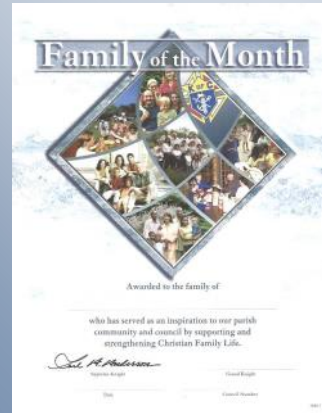

Unfinished Business

Resolution in support of Persecuted Christians in the Middle East—A motion was made to donate \$2,000 to Christian Refugee Relief Fund.

Polo Shirts Purchase – Brought from the table. After some discussion, Pete R withdrew his motion.

Sept 13 Rosary – Brought from the table. This was a motion to start a Rosary on the 13th of each month. This was changed to a Rosary on Sept 13 @ 7pm and Oct 13th and will be revisited in the future.

PFH Chair search – Del S stepped up to chair the council’s PFH efforts.

Opening on the council board of officers – Treasurer – Ron Wagenhals is retiring and leaving the area in December 2015. It was mentioned that an election needs to take place in November. Please contact WGK, WT, or any officer if you are interested in taking this position.

CRE Funds Transition Team – Pete C thanked the Transition Team for helping him get a handle on this. Pete read his point paper,

which highlighted the following (1) The CRE has been dissolved as a separate entity; (2) The monies are being transferred in to the council; (3) The Council needs to continue funding the charities in the approved CRE budget for 2015; (3) a budget needs to be created for charities for 2016; (4) Need to retain the paperwork for 7 years; (5) Money raised for specific events need to go to that specific charity. There was discussion on a "lock box", and being careful to not become an inactive council. When monies are expended from the monies – the trustees must be informed.

New Business

Charity in the Land of the New Martyrs

Christians displaced in the face of religious persecution receive aid through the Order's Christian Refugee Relief Fund

Since the Knights of Columbus Christian Refugee Relief Fund launched in August 2014 to support those suffering persecution in Iraq and Syria, anti-Christian violence in the region has reached unimaginable dimensions. For more than a year, a campaign of religious cleansing by the Islamic State group has terrorized Christian communities and other religious minorities in the region. Confronted with a stark ultimatum — convert to Islam, pay *jizya* (a submission tax), leave or be killed — hundreds of thousands have fled their ancestral Christian homeland.

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In response to the humanitarian crisis, more than \$3 million has so far been distributed through the Order's Christian Refugee Relief Fund to help persecuted Iraqis, Syrians and other refugees. The Supreme Council has also urged members and their families to pray for those affected.

"Our twin efforts are a concrete response to Pope Francis' request for prayers and material assistance for those affected by this terrible persecution," explained Supreme Knight Carl A. Anderson. "We are asking our members, and all people of good will, to pray for those persecuted and to support our efforts to assist them by donating to this fund."

So far, the Chaldean Catholic Archdiocese of Erbil, Iraq, and the Melkite Greek Catholic Archdiocese of Aleppo, Syria, have utilized donations from the fund. Other gifts have gone to assist the Holy See's relief efforts in the Middle East, as well as to help Catholic communities suffering from the violent conflict in Ukraine, where the Order established a formal presence in 2013.
