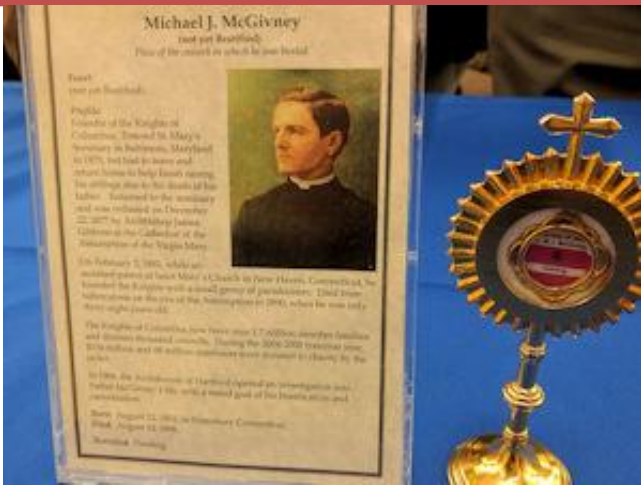

**Colors of the Fourth Degree**

Have you been to a Church function, a Funeral or Parade and have seen the Fourth Degree Color Corps and wondered what the different Colors mean?



Here is an explanation for you:

**Red** – The Red Cape and Chapeau with White Feathers signifies members of the Color Corps.

**Purple** – Is worn by the Color Corps/Assembly Commander. He is in charge of the local Assembly Color Corp/Honor Guard and leads the ceremonies at the local level when the District Marshal is not present.

**White** – Is worn by the Current Faithful Navigator & Past Faithful Navigators

**Dark Green** – Is worn by the District Marshal. He is in charge of all the Color Corps in the District in which he serves. There can be more than one District Marshal as appointed by the District Master.

**Gold** – This is worn by the District Master of the Fourth Degree. The District Master is in charge of membership of the Fourth Degree in his assigned District. There are two District Masters in Washington State, Master Eugene Daly for Western Washington and Master Thomas Sokol in Eastern Washington.

**Light Blue** – Signifies the Vice Supreme Master who serves a region of the order. Our Current Vice Supreme Master is Karl Hadley.

**Dark Blue** – Signifies the Supreme Master who presides over all of the members of the Fourth Degree in the Order.

The Sword is not only a symbol of the Fourth Degree but doubles as a cross when is no Cross to bear at Mass.
