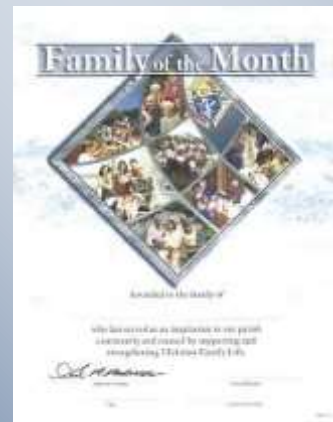


Family of the Month for May
