I have name badges ready for pick up. If you need a Travelcard Cover and / or Card Sleeve, let me know.


#### Adopt-A-Family Wash

Santa Claus, Brother Rusty Waters who MC'd the White Elephant gift exchange was assisted by his special ELF (wife Mary).




















Dear Brother Knights,

Do you recall the phrase: "Tempus fugit, memento mori (Time flies, remember death)"? When preparing your EOL plans to help your spouse or your executor of your will in order to carry out your final wishes, one wish you may have is to have an Honor Guard present at your funeral Mass to pay you that final tribute.

One of the duties as a 4<sup>th</sup> Degree Knight is to participate as a member of an Honor Guard. When the call goes out for an Honor Guard, please consider stepping up to be part of the Honor Guard

We, 4<sup>th</sup> Degree Knights, should, if possible, participate as an Honor Guard member to provide funeral honors to one of our own.

St. Augustine's Pancake Breakfast will be held on January 19<sup>th</sup>.




Pancakes and sausages will be served after both 8am and 9:30am Masses in the parish hall. Bring the family and enjoy!
