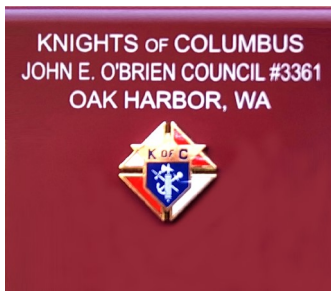
(2) Honorary Member / Honorary Life Member plastic cards. If you need a replacement card let me know.
